## **OUR MISSION**

We're not an orphanage. We're not a children's home. We are a family-based care ministry dedicated to making Jesus known to the orphaned and vulnerable children in Rwanda through wholistic development.





**Our hearts are filled with immense gratitude for the opportunity to bless not one, but two families with complete home remodels.** These families were living in truly precarious and unsafe conditions, facing daily challenges that we can scarcely imagine. To be able to step in has been an incredibly rewarding experience. Witnessing the transformation – from despair to hope, from fear to security – has been truly humbling and inspiring.





Writing is a foundational part of our sponsorship ministry. Through communication with your child, you have the ability to provide advice, encouragement, support, and love that will change their life in more ways than you can imagine. And most importantly, you have the ability to share about the love of Jesus.

**In 2024, we were able to coordinate over 219 letters from sponsors and send 906 letters from our kiddos.**





Every year we visit each child at their home to check on them and determine if there are any specific needs affecting the child or his/her family. If so, we do everything in our power to advocate, provide, and find solutions. Through these efforts, we were able to provide immediate basic need assistance to our children and their families.

**Items might include...**

Doctor-prescribed medication

Hygiene materials

Mattresses replacements

Clothes and shoes

Home repairs

Living expenses assistance



**\$3,744 in special gifts like birthday, Christmas, graduation, or even family assistance was coordinated this year.**

And not only were the funds responsibly tracked, but they were appropriately used as our local leaders worked with the caregivers to meet specific basic needs such as food, clothing, or new mattresses. Sometimes, it was simply elected to use the birthday funds to throw a rarely-experienced birthday party!

**Discipleship**

Each week our leaders take time to open up the Word with the kids, sharing with them the love that Jesus has for them and guiding our kiddos in Scripture memory.

**Education**

Our leaders frequently conduct school visits to meet with our students and their teachers which gives us a first-hand glance into their performance. Branch managers provide additional support, through tutoring and accountability, to help kids succeed academically.

**Civic Responsibility**

Our leaders are always teaching our students about the importance of giving back to their communities through service days and community projects.

**Entertainment**

Kids need an avenue to explore their passions and talents to develop their gifts and interests. So don't be surprised if you visit one of our sectors and see our children stomping the runway, practicing their karate, or participating in traditional Rwandan dances.





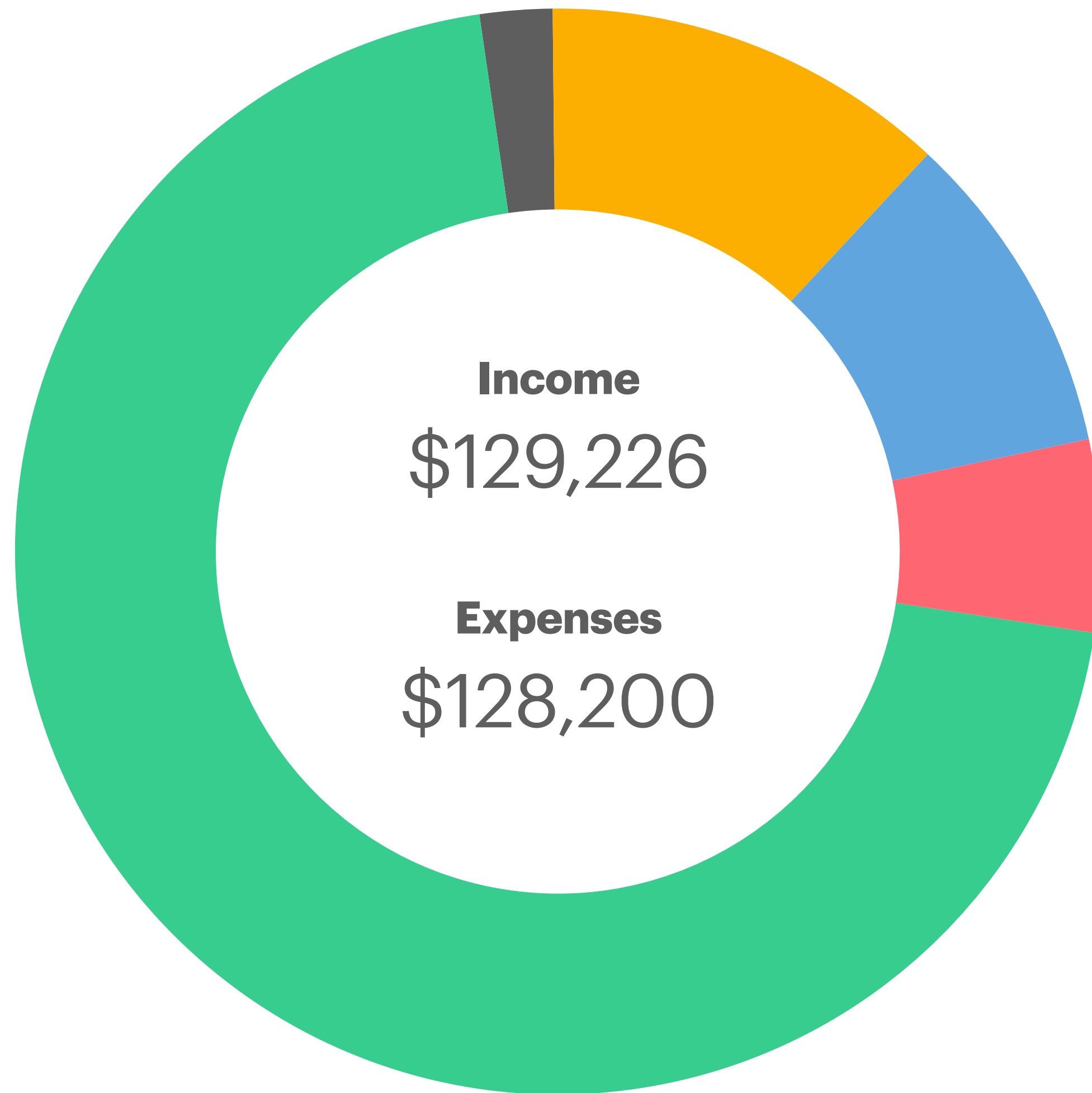
**Moving beyond charity and into development, Best Family continued our focus on increasing economic capacity within our family units through micro-loans in order to decrease their need for financial aid.**
